



DECORATING WITH BOTANICAL-INSPIRED PIECES

- Keep the rest of your furnishings monochromatic for a modern, graphical look.
- Combine with natural materials and textiles, such as wood, stone and linen, for an inviting rustic look.
- Pick out colours from the prints and replicate the colour combination with other furnishings.
- Feel free to mix and match different prints, but bear in mind the scale. For example, if you have a wallpaper with large-scale leaf prints, go for throw cushions that feature smaller prints.
- Experiment with materials and furnishing pieces in colours that contrast with green, such as flamingo pink and orchid purple, for vivid interiors. ▶
